During our inspections we give out information and discuss with the owner or manager information regarding BMP's on controlling FOG and set up a cleaning schedule for your grease trap or interceptor. All information is documented and filed.

Once the information and cleaning schedules have been set, it is the **responsibility of the establishment** to make sure these BMP's are followed and cleaning schedules are kept up to date. The legal authority to inspect and require maintenance is established in (Sewer Use Ordinance No. 1413, Section 2, and Section 3.2 & 3.8).

Failure to maintain an approved pretreatment device such as a Grease Interceptor or Grease Trap could result in penalties and fines as established in the City Sewer Use Ordinance and the Industrial Pretreatment Enforcement Response manual.
