

# LIBRARY MISSION

---

Founded in 1924 by over 100 Canby women, the Canby Women's Civic Club was formed by "ladies interested in a better community and a clean and attractive city." In addition to civic projects such as tree planting (many of which still grace downtown Canby), the Canby Women's Civic Club began a small volunteer library in 1925, but soon realized that the community deserved more. In 1935, the group endorsed a "proper library for Canby" and three of its members led the way towards making this dream a reality. In 1937, Portia Shewey, Mabel Gabriel and Edna Johnson went door to door to ask for the community's support, gathering 643 books and a "tidy sum of cash" to start a public library.

Use of the library has grown steadily over time. When the current library opened in the late 1980s, the library circulated about 77,000 items annually. Two decades later, circulation now exceeds 340,000 items a year. Over a thousand children and youth participate in Summer Reading annually. Thousands more attend programs, view library exhibits, access the Internet, or visit the library for help with job searching, homework or research.

**Canby Public Library serves as a center of community life and discourse, offering opportunities for people to enrich their lives through educational, cultural, and artistic experiences. The library safeguards the future of its community by promoting print and technological literacy, the free expression of ideas, and lifelong learning among its citizens.**



# THE NEW LIBRARY

---

Located in the heart of downtown Canby, the design of the new 35,000 sf library and civic building focuses on the flow of public space through the site as it engages one of Canby's most lively streets.

Greeting the east side of the library will be an airy public plaza. The scenic parkway will be filled with trees and benches, providing readers and passerbys with a place to relax and delve deep into a new book.

The interior of the new library centers around varied community uses, and contains the Canby Public Library's extensive book and media collection, cozy places to sit and read, gathering areas, computer stations, children and teen areas, and flexible meeting rooms for the community use.

The new library fulfills the mission of Canby Public Library as a center of community life and discourse in Canby.
