New Business	<p>Intro to Councilman Waterman, new liaison. Jerry– New projects: S Ivy, storm system/underground work in progress. Will be traffic signal at Township, will look like Sequoia Pkwy. Should be complete Oct 2025. NE 10th-Pine to Locust reconstruction. Redwood paved, ADA improvements multiple places. Urban renewal in process of paving downtown alleys/lighting. Path from logging bridge to 99-almost ready to get a bid on existing design (under urban renewal district.) If pushed through, could be completed this summer. Plans for fuel station to operate emergency services for a few months. Walnut St. IGA approved, awaiting ODOT approval of construction plans. City has Maple between golf course and Territorial. For sidewalks, go to Jerry or Traffic Safety Committee. School areas of concern: Township near Pine, the City can't do sidewalks unless property owners agree. Logging Rd, tree roots are the biggest issue, but it would take money to fix. Bruce asks Jerry to get the data on what the repaving needs are. Jerry will be doing an inventory/scan of all roads, but didn't ask for Logging Rd. Redwood-possible to put another crosswalk around 11th. To get a problem area addressed, it takes time, just need to keep bringing it up w/ city councilors, individually and at council meetings. Get more people to advocate as well. Jerry plans to redo CIP, we'd fall under Streets.
