

Population Growth in Canby




Canby is steadily growing! Population forecasts indicate that nearly 6,000 residents will be added to Canby over the next 20 years. The Hispanic/Latino population makes up about 18 percent of the total city population.

67 percent of Canby residents own their home and 33 percent rent. Nearly 1 in 5 renter households in Canby are severely rent burdened with over 50% of their income going towards monthly housing costs.

The median household income in Canby is \$83,948, which can afford a home mortgage of about \$430,000. The average home price in Canby is around \$582,000 and the average gross rent is \$1,230.
