



Vision Themes

- A community for all ages- Encourage housing options for all stages of life and support entertainment and recreational activities for seniors, families, and youth.
- Small-town atmosphere- Maintain access to nature and farmland vistas, prioritize community safety, and facilitate thoughtful growth.
- Diverse and prosperous economy- Support existing small businesses, especially
 within downtown, and recruit businesses with high-paying jobs and services for local
 residents.

Vision Themes

- Sound public infrastructure- Update power and water systems to support Canby's growth. Improve OR 99E conditions and overall road congestion and enhance pedestrian and bicycle connections.
- Strong sense of community pride- Celebrate Canby's diversity and uniqueness through local events, community celebrations, and lasting organizations.
- Network of connected greenspaces- Maintain and expand park facilities and open spaces, such as Wait Park and the Logging Road Trail.
