### Teen Liaison process.

Jen and Lois went to the high school and met with the librarian. New applications went out and slides on the process were made for the Club Fair. They talked to several club teachers, school staff, and students. Most students were not interested. Lois sent a new email to all the students that applied at the end of last school year. Those students will have to apply again because the new application has changed and has a part for parental consent. New applications are due October 1<sup>st</sup>.

The next step is to figure out days and times to do interviews. LAB decided on October 5th and 12th. Not all members will be on the panel as that would be too overwhelming for candidates. We also need to figure out what questions to ask and send those in advance to the candidates.

### CPL Strategic Plan 24-27

With two edits to make, one being to spell out what LINCC stands for on the last page of the document and the second being to define what "community" means in the document, a motion was made by Lois to approve the plan. Kristi seconded. All in favor. Opposed: None.

The new plan will be presented to City Council at the October 23, 2024 City Council meeting for review and adoption.

  - We have several new adult programs starting in September, including Adult Craft Night, <u>B.Y.O.Book</u> Club, and Canby Public Library writing group. We also have a <u>Financial</u> info series starting up on 9/18, a Beginner Watercolor Class on 9/21, and a Guide to Garlic Planting on 9/28. No sign-ups required.
  - Northwest Classical Theatre Collaborative will be performing a 75-minute production of The Year of Magical Thinking, with live music, directed by Patrick Walsh, at the library on 10/17 from 6:30-8pm.
  - The young teen and parent craft is moving to a new time, now starting at 5pm, on the 2nd and 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of each month.
