

**RESOLUTION NO. 1045**

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING CLACKAMAS COUNTY SURRENDER JURISDICTION OF SE 13<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE BETWEEN THE EASTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY OF S. IVY STREET AND A POINT APPROXIMATELY 358 FEET EAST OF THE EASTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY OF SE TEAKWOOD STREET TOTALING APPROXIMATELY 3,952 LINEAR FEET**

**WHEREAS**, the City has completed street and traffic calming improvements to SE 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue between the easterly right-of-way of S. Ivy Street and the easterly right-of-way of S. Redwood Street; and

**WHEREAS**, Clackamas County maintains jurisdictional control of SE 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue between S. Ivy Street and Mulino Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to assume jurisdictional control of SE 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue between the easterly right-of-way of S. Ivy Street and a point approximately 358 linear feet east of the easterly right-of-way of SE Teakwood Street totaling approximately 3,952 linear feet; and


**WHEREAS**, pursuant to ORS 373.270(6)(a), the City Council may initiate the surrender of county jurisdiction over a county road by passage of appropriate municipal legislation;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Canby, as follows:


- (1) Clackamas County is hereby requested to surrender jurisdiction over SE 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue between the easterly right-of-way of S. Ivy Street and a point approximately 358 linear feet east of the easterly right-of-way of SE Teakwood Street totaling approximately 3,952 linear feet.

This resolution will take effect on October 7, 2009.
