

RESOLUTION NO. CXLVI

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO FRESH AND PLASTIC FLOWERS AT ZION MEMORIAL PARK; PROVIDING FOR ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE MOWING SEASON; AND CHANGING RESOLUTION NO. CXIV.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Canby City Council that:

1. For the balance of the mowing season in this 1972 calendar year and during the mowing season in each calendar year hereafter, no fresh or plastic flowers shall be permitted to remain in Zion Memorial Park between the hours of 1:00 o'clock p.m. Monday until 5:00 p.m. Thursday. This prohibition shall not apply, however, to Easter Sunday, Memorial Day, Mother's Day, Father's Day or the two (2) days immediately following those days.
2. The mowing season for this calendar year shall continue from this date until October 15, 1972.
3. The commencement of the mowing season for each calendar year hereafter shall be determined by the Superintendent of Public Works and announced by him at least one (1) week in advance by publication in the Canby Herald and also by notices posted in at least three (3) conspicuous places in the Cemetery.
4. The mowing season for each year hereafter shall continue from the announced date until October 15th.
5. Fresh or plastic flowers which are left in Zion Memorial Park in violation of these regulations shall be deemed abandoned by the owners, and the City's work force shall have authority to dispose of such items without liability to the City or any of its officers or employees.
6. Notice of these regulations shall be given by publishing this Resolution in its entirety in the next two (2) successive issues of the Canby Herald, and then in one (1) publication of the same paper prior to the commencement of each mowing season hereafter.
7. The regulations hereby established shall become effective on this date and remain in effect hereafter until changed by another

Resolution of the Council.


8. Resolution No. CXIV adopted July 6, 1971, is superseded and changed by this Resolution immediately upon the first publication of this Resolution in the Canby Herald.
