

RESOLUTION CLVI

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS.

WHEREAS, an occurrence, condition or need exists which had not been ascertained at the time the City's current budget was adopted; and

WHEREAS, funds have been made available from Federal revenue sharing receipts which could not have been ascertained at the time the current budget was adopted; and the total estimated receipts, including earned interest thereon, is \$53,000 and were or will be distributed to the City for general fund requirements as hereinafter provided, and it is necessary that a supplemental budget be approved and the expenditures authorized.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Canby City Council hereby adopts the supplemental budget which was prepared and approved initially by the Canby City Council on April 2, 1973, and approved formally and finally after a public hearing on Monday, April 23, 1973, and which was advertised by Notice given in the manner and for the time required by law. A Notice of said supplemental budget hearing specifying the previously unanticipated receipts and also the proposed expenditures was published in the Canby Herald, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon, on April 11, 1973.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the estimated additional receipts for the fiscal year 1972-73 to the general fund from Federal revenue sharing receipts and earned interest thereon in the total sum of \$53,000 be and they hereby are appropriated for the purposes shown below and as follows:


