FIRST AMENDMENT TO PERSONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

The City of Canby, Oregon ("City") and Waterleaf Architecture, LLC ("Contractor") enter into this First Amendment. This First Amendment will be effective when both parties have signed it.

RECITALS

- A. The City and Contractor entered into a personal services agreement (the "Agreement") on or about October ___, 2023. Pursuant to the Agreement, Contractor is providing design services to the City for a new Canby Area Transit administration building.
- B. Through this First Amendment, the parties wish to add additional services to Contractor's existing scope of work. The additional services relate to demonstrating compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act ("NEPA"), which the Federal Transit Authority is requiring of the City.
- C. Except for adding the NEPA-related services to Contractor's existing scope of work, and increasing Contractor's compensation accordingly, the parties otherwise reaffirm the terms and conditions of the Agreement.

AGREEMENT

- 1. The parties amend the Agreement to expand Contractor's scope of work to include NEPA-related services, and to increase Contractor's compensation in the amount of \$79,966.00 for those services, as specifically described in Exhibit A, which is attached to this First Amendment and incorporated by reference.
- 2. Except for the specific changes the parties make to the Agreement through this First Amendment, the terms and conditions of the Agreement remain effective and enforceable.
